Objectives of the project

- * To increase knowledge on the prevalence and characteristic of experiences of violence and abuse against girls aged 14-18 in residential care and under the legal responsibility of public authorities in the EU.
- * To empower the girls to protect and prevent themselves and their peer from violence against women.



Specific objectives also include:

- * Sensitization of professionals working with girls in residential care about the need to take into account a gender perspective when working with this target group.
- Raise awareness among decision-makers and civil servants in the EU.

Research

DATA COLLECTION FROM GIRLS LI-VING IN RESIDENTIAL CARE

- * Aim: Fieldwork research on the experiences of violence and abuse, perceptions of gender roles and intimate relationships, of 14-18 years old girls in residential care in Spain, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Italy and Finland.
- * Data collection methods:
 - * Individual interviews
 - * Focus Groups
- * Topics of the focus group:
 - Gender roles and stereotypes: differences between men and women, experiences of gender norms/restrictions in daily lives.
 - Close relationships and intimate relationships. Gender roles within them.
